WORK PLANNED FOR NEXT WEEK

- Temporary areas for materials, equipment storage, and construction vehicle routes will begin to be established.
- Invasive plant removal will begin. These are plants and trees that do not naturally belong in this environment and can harm native vegetation. Removing them helps support healthier long-term growth of natural plant life.
- Tree markings - The contractor will begin marking trees with paint, that will be removed later in the week. The majority of these trees are invasive species.
- The contractor will begin earth work of the site with large construction vehicles.

SPECIAL NOTES

Equipment deliveries at Cleveland-Massillon Road – Construction equipment will be delivered to the site from Cleveland-Massillon Road. During unloading, one lane of traffic may be temporarily closed. Traffic will be maintained, but drivers may experience brief delays.

Work starting on the west side – The first phase of work will take place on the west side of Cleveland-Massillon Road within the project area.
